## TEAM ENTRY FEES:

Team entries are now open for the 2022 CYGNETT ACC and **must be submitted online** at [www.stadium34.com.au/acc](http://www.stadium34.com.au/acc)

**Tournament Team Entry Fee:** \$900.00 per team (inc. insurance coverage for all players)  
A **DEPOSIT** of \$50 is required to secure your spot upon entry. The remaining \$850 will be added to your teams statement in Spawtz once entry is completed. This can then be paid at any stage leading up to or at the tournament.

Team entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and entries will close on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2022, unless exhausted earlier. There are limited spots in each division.

**If you've entered a team in 2020 or 2021** – Log in to Spawtz ([stadium34.spawtz.com](http://stadium34.spawtz.com)) using your log in details. You can then register your existing team to the appropriate 2022 division **OR** enter a brand new team.

You can then edit your team list to suit this year's tournament by clicking on your team name in your dashboard and then adding and subtracting players from the list.

**If you are entering a brand-new team** - You will need to get the email addresses and mobile phone numbers of all players to be able to enter the team and register them via [stadium34.spawtz.com](http://stadium34.spawtz.com).

## PAYMENT DETAILS:

Remaining Team Fees can be made at any time prior to the tournament via your Spawtz Dashboard or over the phone via credit card. Cash or credit card payments can also be made at the tournament.

# TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE & FORMAT



## TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

All teams are guaranteed to play a minimum of five games (Pro is a minimum of 4 games). The actual format for each division of the 2022 CYGNETT ACC will be dictated by the number of team entries in that division.

## DIVISIONS:

**The CYGNETT ACC tournament brings the best players and teams from all over Australia.**  
**Pro Division** – *Highest calibre. Teams are made up of highly experienced state and national representative hockey players.*

**Division I** – *High-level tournament/competitive/representative league experience.*

**Division II** – *Competitive level experience and looking for a fun tournament.*

**Division III** – *Recreational level, may be new to the sport or a second division for older players.*

**Masters Division (35+)** – *Individuals that are at least 35 years of age. Goalies and female participants may participate at the age of 30 years or older.*

## INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION:

Players who wish to compete in the CYGNETT ACC (but do not have a team) can register to 'join a team' by filling out the individual player registration at <http://www.stadium34.com.au/acc>

## AGE RESTRICTIONS:

To compete in the senior 2022 CYGNETT ACC, the minimum age for any player (in any division) is 15 years as at 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022.

To be eligible to play in the Masters division, all players must be 35 (or 30 for Females & Goalies) years of age by 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022.

## TEAM/PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY:

The tournament directors reserve the right to place a team or individual in a different division to which they have registered (if they see fit).

You can play a **maximum of three divisions**, if the following team rules are adhered to:

**Pro Division Teams:** No player restrictions.

**Division 1 Teams:** Maximum of **TWO** Pro Division listed players are allowed per roster.

**Division 2 Teams:** Maximum of **TWO** Division 1 listed players are allowed per roster.

*\* No Pro Division players can play in this division.*

**Division 3 Teams:** Maximum of **TWO** Division 2 players (current or previous) are allowed per roster.

*\* No Pro Division, Division 1 or Previous ACC non-listed Division 2 players (unless granted a dispensation) can play in this division.*

**Masters Teams:** Masters is considered a separate division and there are no restrictions to playing in this division, other than age.

# TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE & FORMAT



## FIXTURE REQUESTS:

All fixture and scheduling requests must be made by 14<sup>th</sup> March 2022 by emailing [info@stadium34.com.au](mailto:info@stadium34.com.au). Any requests made after this date will not be considered. All team rosters are "FROZEN" two weeks prior to the first game. **No players may be added after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 without the approval of the tournament directors.**

## DISPENSATIONS:

Team Captains/Organisers must apply for any dispensations relating to participant eligibility through email only – [info@stadium34.com.au](mailto:info@stadium34.com.au)

**Please clearly state the players name, the division in which you are seeking the dispensation, any other divisions the player is playing in and the reason(s) why you require the dispensation to be granted.**

## TEAM ROSTERS:

We encourage teams to consist of 6-8 players and 1 goaltender.

The maximum number of players per team roster is 12 skaters + 2 goaltenders.

A maximum of 2 coaches/managers are allowed on the player benches, in addition to players. No one under the age of 15 is permitted on the bench.

## GAME FORMAT:

The start and finish times for each day will be determined by the total number of teams.

Generally, games will start at 7:00am and conclude no later than 12:00am.

**Length of game (Pro division):** 2 x 20 minute halves (two minute halftime break).

**Length of game (All other divisions):** 2 x 15 minute halves (two minute halftime break).

All round robin games will be running time with no timeouts or stop time unless controlled by the referee. All finals games will be played with stop time in the last two minutes (if the score is within one goal at the start of the final 2 minutes).

Each team will be allocated one timeout per finals game.

**Tied finals game:** 5-minute sudden death 3v3 overtime.

**Tied after overtime:** Best of 3 penalty shootout (continuing until a winner is decided).

## SCHEDULE OF GAMES:

The ACC22 Fixture will be available no later than 14 days prior to the commencement of the tournament. The fixture will be available online at [www.stadium34.com.au](http://www.stadium34.com.au) and posted on the Facebook page - [www.facebook.com/ACCHockeyTournament](https://www.facebook.com/ACCHockeyTournament).

## SCORING/STANDINGS:

The tournament will feature online scoring and standings. Peta Goulden will take on the role of head scorer/statistician again this year. Results will be posted on the media screens near the snackbar, on the tournament Facebook page and Hockeysyte.

## PLAYER INSURANCE:

Included in the team entry fee is insurance coverage (provided through Skate Victoria) for all players officially listed on a team. ## TOURNAMENT AWARDS:

Pro division teams will compete for prize money, in a winner take all format. First and second place teams in each of the divisions will be presented with custom ACC medals. Prizes will be awarded to the 'Best Goalie (SV%)', 'Highest Point Scorer' and grand final 'MVP' for all divisions.

## UNIFORMS AND RULE HIGHLIGHTS:

- All games will be played in accordance with the IIHF Inline rule book and a set of 2022 ACC tournament by-laws.
- All teams must wear proper matching hockey jerseys. No self-made jerseys.
- All tournament games will be played with offside, but without icing.
- Minor penalties are two minutes duration.
- Half visors or face cages **MUST BE WORN** on all helmets, in all divisions.
- A **zero tolerance** towards fighting and referee abuse will be enforced.

## HEAD REFEREE:

Daryl Hamilton will take the position of 'referee in charge' for the ninth year running. Daryl will manage the assignment of game referees and oversee the conduct of refereeing throughout the tournament. We believe that refereeing is a key element to the tournament's success, and we will continue to source the best available for this tournament from around the country.

## CHANGE ROOMS:

We request that change rooms be kept in a neat and tidy manner for the duration of the tournament. Players will not be able to leave gear overnight (due to cleaning schedule as part of the COVID Plan). At this stage, teams will be allocated one change room for the entire tournament.
