Stadium 34 is one of Australia's only full size, purpose-built inline hockey rinks. The flooring is the original Inline Hockey specific Sport Court floor (imported from the USA) and the rink is enclosed with full boards and full perspex.

When adding players to your team - You will need their email address (or a parents) to be able to register them to your team.

Team entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and entries will close on the **22nd May 2022**. There are limited spots in each division.

WC STRUCTURE & FORMAT



TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

All teams are guaranteed to play a minimum of four games. The actual format of the 2022 Winter Classic will be dictated by the number of team entries.

DIVISIONS / AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Junior A (U15) – *Must have been 15 years of age or younger at the 1st January 2022.*

Junior B (U12) – *Must have been 12 years of age or younger at the 1st January 2022.*

Development (U9) – *Must have been 9 years of age or younger at the 1st January 2022.*

Senior A & Senior B – *Must be 15 years of age at the 1st June 2022.*

INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION:

Players who wish to compete in the Winter Classic (but do not have a team) can register to 'join a team' by filling out the individual player registration at

TEAM/PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY:

Juniors (U9, U12 & U15):

Players can play in a total of 2 junior divisions (*EG: An 11yo could play in U12 and U15*)

Senior A:

This division is aimed at players that generally play in the Pro Division, Division 1 or Division 2 at the ACC tournament OR the top division of their home league competition.

Senior B:

This division is aimed at players that generally play in Division 2 or Division 3 at the ACC tournament or a lower division of their home league competition.

Please Note: If you are unsure about which division to enter your team into, please contact us to discuss it further.

The tournament director reserves the right to place a team in a different division to which they have registered (if he sees fit and it is in the best interest of the competition).

DISPENSATIONS:

Team organisers must apply for any dispensations relating to participant eligibility through email only – info@stadium34.com.au

Please clearly state the players name, the division in which you are seeking the dispensation, any other divisions the player is playing in and the reason(s) why you require the dispensation to be granted.

WC STRUCTURE & FORMAT



FIXTURE REQUESTS:

All fixture and scheduling requests must be made by 22nd May 2022 by emailing info@stadium34.com.au. Any requests made after this date will not be considered. All team rosters are "FROZEN" on the 29th May. **No players may be added after 29th May 2022 without the approval of the tournament directors.**

TEAM ROSTERS:

We encourage teams to consist of 8 players and 1 goaltender. The maximum number of players per team roster is 12 skaters + 2 goaltenders. A maximum of 3 coaches/managers are allowed on the player benches, in addition to players. No one under the age of 15 is permitted on the bench as a non-player.

GAME FORMAT:

The start and finish times for each day will be determined by the total number of teams. All round robin games will be running time with no timeouts or stop time, unless controlled by the referee. All finals games will be played with stop time in the last two minutes if the score is within one goal at the start of the final 2 minutes.

Each team will be allocated one timeout per finals game.

Tied finals game: 5-minute sudden death 3v3 overtime.

Tied after overtime: Best of 3 penalty shootout (continuing through team list until a winner is decided).

SCHEDULE OF GAMES:

The 2022 Winter Classic Fixture will be available no later than 14 days prior to the commencement of the tournament. The fixture will be available online and circulated to teams. The fixture will be available online at www.stadium34.com.au and posted on the Facebook page - www.facebook.com/ACCHockeyTournaments.

SCORING/STANDINGS:

The tournament will feature online scoring and standings. Peta Goulden will take on the role of head scorer/statistician. Results will be posted on the media screens near the snackbar, on the tournament Facebook page and our Hockeysyte page.

OTHER TOURNAMENT INFORMATION



TOURNAMENT AWARDS:

First and second place teams in each of the divisions will be presented with custom Winter Classic medals. Prizes will be awarded to the 'Best Goalie (SV%)', 'Highest Point Scorer' and grand final 'MVP' for all divisions.

UNIFORMS AND RULE HIGHLIGHTS:

- All games will be played in accordance with the IIHF Inline rule book and a set of 2022 Winter Classic tournament by-laws.
- All teams must wear matching hockey jerseys.
- SENIOR games will be played with offside, but without icing.
- JUNIOR games will be played without offside and icing rules.
- Minor penalties are two minutes duration.
- Full face cages **MUST BE WORN** on all helmets, in all junior divisions.
- Half visors or face cages **MUST BE WORN** on all helmets, in all senior divisions.
- A **zero tolerance** towards fighting and referee abuse will be enforced.

CHANGE ROOMS / WARM UP AREA:

We request that change rooms be kept in a neat and tidy manner for the duration of the tournament. Teams will be allocated one change room for the entire tournament.

PLAYER INSURANCE:

Insurance is provided through Skate Victoria. All players must be Skate Victoria members (\$25). If you have played in the ACC, Bendigo Cup or Viking Cup then you will be a current member and do not need to pay anything.
